



WHAT'S NEW?

October 3rd marks the launch of a pilot for a new enhanced classroom support single day service, named LINK (Launch Inclusion and Navigate Knowledge) which you can register for without the use of the ECSIT. With the identification of a specific classroom need related to challenges with full inclusion of all children, you can access an inclusion facilitator to collaborate alongside your team, with a focus on behaviour, transitions, gaining confidence in inclusive practices or managing medical supports.
