OUR CURRENT SERVICES

Community Living Hamilton Special Needs Resourcing Department has continued to work remotely since the closure of the licensed child care centres. SNR Supervisors and Resource Consultants are available to support educators who are engaged with families at home. If you are interested in discussing strategies to assist families with behaviour, daily routines, or tips on how to smoothly transition back to child care, contact your Resource Consultant, or the SNR Supervisor who is assigned to your area.

School Entry meetings for the HWDSB and HWCDSB will still occur for those children who will enter school in September. Both boards are looking at creative solutions to offer meetings virtually, and are in the process of contacting families. Please reassure families while they are waiting. As Resource Consultants complete school entry reports, they will contact you to let you know that reports are done, and that they will be contacting families to get parent approval.
